## **Session Breakdown**

#### Session 1: Introduction and Assessment

- Duration: 1 unit (30 minutes)
- Topics Covered:

  - Discuss potential barriers and strategies for overcoming them
- Outcome: Completed individual transition plan outline

### Session 2: Exploring Post-Secondary Options

- Duration: 2 units (1 hour)

- Outcome: List of potential post-secondary programs with key application steps

- Duration: 2 units (1 hour)

  - Organizational tools and strategies for success
  - Basics of effective communication in academic and workplace settings
- Outcome: Personalized academic and organizational skill-building plan

#### Session 4: Self-Advocacy and Accessibility

- Duration: 1 unit (30 minutes)
- Topics Covered:
  - Self-advocacy techniques for requesting accommodations
  - Navigating disability services and understanding ADA compliance
- Outcome: Plan for accessing resources and accommodations at chosen institutions

### Session 5: Final Planning and Follow-Up



- Duration: 2 units (1 hour)
- Topics Covered:
  - Reviewing the transition plan
  - Finalizing applications and next steps
  - Establishing a follow-up schedule for ongoing support
- Outcome: Completed transition plan with clear next steps and follow-up schedule

### **Assessment and Success Metrics:**

Participants will be evaluated based on:

- 1. Completion of an individualized transition plan.
